## 1. INTRODUCTION

We are very proud to announce the excellent results achieved by our high school Spanish students on the National Spanish Exam. This year our students competed in levels 1 through 5. A total of 160,753 students participated this year in the United States.

Honorable Mentions are given to students placing in the 50th - 74th percentiles, Bronze certificates and medals are given to students placing in the 75th - 84th percentiles, Silver certificates and medals are given to students placing in the 85th - 94th percentiles in the nation, and Gold certificates and medals are given to students placing in the 95th - 99th percentiles in the nation on the exam.

In addition, the very highest gold scorers in all categories in the State of Michigan are given monetary awards and plaques. Of the 13 "top-gold" winners in the state of Michigan this year, $\mathbf{6}$ are Greenhills students. Certificates, medals, and monetary awards will be distributed in class. Sr. Olson, Sra.
